RESOLUTION NO. 12 - 2021

**ADOPT THE 2021 SOUTHEAST ALABAMA REGIONAL
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Geneva County Emergency Management Agency has engaged in extensive studies of the hazards facing all of Geneva County, including the Town of Malvern; and

WHEREAS, the Geneva County Emergency Management Agency, with guidance from the Geneva County Local Emergency Planning Committee and as required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, has prepared the 2021 Southeast Alabama Regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan which supersedes any and all existing hazard mitigation plans; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Malvern, Alabama was provided with ample and adequate opportunity to participate in the hazard mitigation planning process and is represented on the Geneva County Local Emergency Planning Committee; and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of this plan are to reduce the loss of life, property damage, and economic loss; make Geneva County less vulnerable to natural disasters; and to provide education about hazards and hazard mitigation options; and,

WHEREAS, the strategies of this plan are to identify and characterize hazards, access risk, prioritize and implement mitigation measures; and,

WHEREAS, adoption and implementation of the 2021 Southeast Alabama Regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan would be in the best interest and protection of the citizens of the Town of Malvern.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Malvern, Alabama does hereby adopt the document entitled the 2021 Southeast Alabama Regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
