**RESOLUTION NO. 13-2023
TO APPROVE QUALIFIED RAA EXPENDITURES, GAS TAX FUNDS, AND GENERAL FUND
REVENUE FOR TOWN OF MALVERN'S
ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE.**

WHEREAS, the United States Congress passed the Rebuild Alabama Act No. 2019-2, effective March 12, 2019 ("RAA" or the "Act").

WHEREAS, the Act was created to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvement, preservation and maintenance of roads and bridges, and

WHEREAS, Town of Malvern receives distributions monthly ("RAA Funds") through the thru the State, in addition to Gas tax funds, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Malvern, has elected to take \$70,000.00 from RAA Funds and Gas Tax funds, and \$130,000.00, from the General Fund, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Malvern has identified roads that need resurfacing, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Malvern has applied for the Rebuild Alabama Annual Grant Project, the need to use the funds for expenditures which, in the judgment of the Council, qualifies as a permitted use of the those funds,

NOW THEREFORE, by the Town Council of Malvern, Alabama, that:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Council believes, in exercising its reasonable judgment, that the Expenditure meets the criteria of permissible expenditure of RAA Funds, and Gas Tax funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
